7 Speed Watch-update

LM reported that 6 Speed watch sessions had now been held and approx. 33% of vehicles targeted in one session were over the 30 MPH speed limit. It was agreed that this was a clear indication that 30 MPH repeater signs were needed to be replaced along Lynsted Lane. Cllr Bowles informed the members that the next Joint Transport meeting was on 2nd December therefore it was decided to write before the deadline of mid-November to ask for these signs to be reinstated or for 30mph signs to be painted on the road.
